N.B. Non-Collegiate candidates are not eligible to offer dissertation.

There shall be 10 questions in each theory paper, including 02 questions from each unit. Each question paper will contain five units.

Candidates shall attempt 05 questions, selecting at least one question from each unit. Each question carries equal marks.

Only such candidates shall be permitted to offer dissertation in lieu of a paper as have secured atleast 55% marks in the aggregate of all the papers prescribed for the previous examination in the case of annual scheme.

Non-Collegiate candidates both in previous and final year are required to attend a practical training camp of forty eight hours at the Department of Geography on papyment of fee fixed by the University from time to time. The candidate should contact the Head, Department of Geography for practical camps immediately after the filling the examination forms. Head, Department of Geography will issue a Certificate to each of the non-collegiate candidate for successful completion of the training camp. The candidates have to submit the certificate at the time of practical examination.

There will be four theory papers and a practical each in Previous and Final Examination. Candidate will be required to pass both in theory and practicals separately.

DISSERTATION

The candidates can offer dissertation on any geographical problem in lieu of any elective paper in final year examination.

N.B.: The candidates will be required to submit dissertation four weeks after the theory examination which will be examined by a board of two examiners. Three copies of dissertation will be submitted to the University out of which one copy will be returned to the Department/College and one to the supervisor.

The dissertation should exclusively be based on secondary data and statistical analysis as far as possible and prepared under the guidance of a post graduate teacher of five year standing. The volume of the dissertation will not exceed 100 pages.
